Zelia Lobato, a lawyer for the government, and her son, Junior a fireman, hosted me in their home. It was a pleasant time except for my injury. I had taught all day Saturday, had a break and hurried into the house, but stumbled over a flood drain and hit my face on the concrete. They rushed me to the hospital for stitches above my eye and X-rays. Nothing broken , but my eye was very black. They cleaned the blood out of my hair and I went back and taught the last session. On Sunday afternoon I had they took me to the Equator and I stood over it with one foot South and the other North. My time there was the three days of the Equinox!

One day the sun was on the south side, then directly above, then on the North for the beginning of our summer! Back to church, we went out witnessing. Junior was my interpreter. He, Zelia and I led 7 people to Christ who lived right next to the church building. Zelia wonderfully instructed the new Believers in what to do next. We all rejoiced! Then they took me to the Airport to head to Belem. What a great way to end my first trip to Amapa!
